# Why United Way?







#### ALICE

ALICE is an acronym for Asset Limited, Income Constrained, Employed — households that earn more than the Federal Poverty Level, but less than the basic cost of living for the county. While conditions have improved for some households, many continue to struggle with the rising cost of household essentials (housing, child-care, food, transportation, health care, and a basic smartphone plan). Households below the ALICE Threshold — ALICE households plus those in poverty — can't afford the essentials.

In our community, which mirrors State averages, 15% of our households are in poverty with an additional 30% are ALICE households for a total of 45% struggling to make ends meet.
